

SIGNS & SYMPTOMS **DEXTROMETHORPHAN**

Street Names

Robotripping, Robo, Triple C's (Coricidin)

Method of Use

Orally (in tablet, gel cap, or liquid form)

Pain Medications

Dextromethorphan (DXM) is the active ingredient found in over-the-counter (OTC) cough/cold medications such as Robitussin, Vicks, Coricidin, and Mucinex,

Not all types of cough/cold medications contain DXM, it will be identified on the label.



Symptoms/ Effects of Use

- Numbness
- Nausea/vomiting
- · In high doses it can produce dissociative or out-of-body experiences or hallucinations (similar to PCP/ketamine)
- · Increased heart rate
- · Increased blood pressure
- Impaired motor function



What to look for...

- · Hidden, empty bottles/packages of cold medication
- Mood swings
- · Erratic behavior
- Hallucinations
