

SIGNS & SYMPTOMS COCAINE

Street Names

Blow, C, Candy, Coke, Crack, Rock, Nose candy, Snow, Toot

Method of Use

Smoked, Snorted, Injected

Symptoms/ Effects of Use

- Euphoria
- Increased energy and mental alertness to sights, sounds, touch
- Talkative
- · Dilated pupils
- · Decreased appetite
- · Bizarre, erratic, violent behavior
- · Restlessness/ decreased sleep
- Irritability, anxiety, panic/paranoia
- · Constricted blood vessels
- Nasal tissue destruction (from snorting)
- · Abdominal pain/nausea
- Malnourishment
- · Increased body temperature
- Increased blood pressure
- Increased heart rate
- Heart attack/respiratory failure
- Stroke
- Seizure
- Death (mostly due to cardiac arrest or seizures)

What to look for...

- · Bloodshot eyes
- Dilated pupils (especially in low lighting - difficult to see any eye color around the pupil)
- · Insomnia
- Irritability
- Frequent mood swings
- Nosebleeds
- Nervousness, anxiety attacks, paranoia
- · Weight loss
- Sweating
- Quick thoughts/movements with abnormally high energy

Withdrawal Symptoms

- Depression ("Crash", rest/recuperation for several days)
- · Fatigue/sleepiness
- Anxiety
- Cravings
- · Vivid, unpleasant dreams
- · Increased appetite
