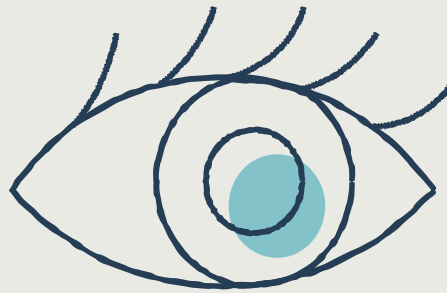

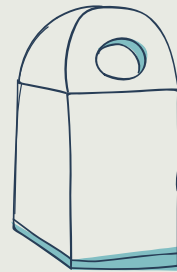
Lock

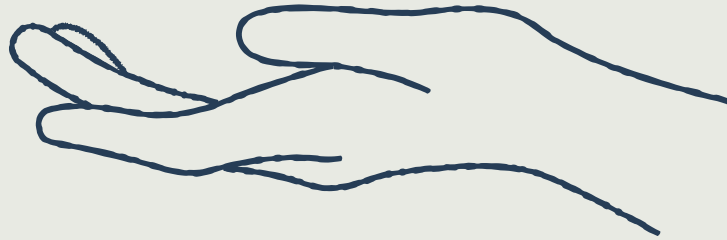
